# Studying and researching in Germany with scholarships<sup>2</sup>

## I. Before you start looking for scholarships

- Know exactly what you want to do and why!
- Look for the right study program at the right university / for the right research partner!
- Contact the university/partner and check if you meet their requirements
  - Master degree required? Language skills required?
- Upgrade and certify your language skills!

#### II. Scholarship programs for Kazakh students for studying in Germany

- 1) Scholarship programs of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)
  - a) University summer courses in Germany 3
    - for students (after 2 academic years) and graduates
    - a wide range of summer schools in German and English
  - b) Study visits by groups of students
    - for groups up to 15 students up to 12 days
    - must be organized by lecturer
  - c) Master/postgraduate courses
    - for graduates
    - 10 to 24 months; also for one year in Germany as part of a master's/second degree completed at home university
    - scholarship does not cover tuition fees (but most study programs in German language are free)
    - special programs in the fields architecture, fine art/design/film, performing art and music
  - d) Development-related postgraduate courses
    - for graduates with at least two years' professional experience
  - e) ERP scholarships for graduates of economics and business administration
    - 18 to 24 months, for excellently qualified graduates

#### 2) Scholarship programs of political foundations

- Konrad Adenauer Stiftung (cconservatives)
- Friedrich Ebert Foundation (social democrats)
- Heinrich Böll Foundation (greens)
- Rosa Luxemburg Foundation (leftists)
- Friedrich Naumann Foundation (liberals)
- Stiftung der Deutschen Wirtschaft (Foundation of German Business)
- *3) Other scholarship programs* (examples)
  - <u>Deutschlandstipendium</u> (additional scholarships financed by the Federal Government and private sponsors but granted by some universities)
  - scholarship programs for Catholic Christians of the <u>Catholic Academic Exchange Service (KAAD)</u>
  - merit scholarships of the Universität Hamburg

### III. Scholarship programs for Kazakh graduates for researching in Germany

- only for advanced research (not for bachelor or master thesis)
- 1) Scholarship programs of the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD)
  - a) Short term research grants for young researchers
    - for doctoral students and other researchers with master degree, also postdocs
    - for a research project carried out in coordination with German academic advisor
    - 1 to 6 months
  - b) One year research grants for young researchers
    - for doctoral students and other researchers with master degree
    - for a research project carried out in coordination with German academic advisor
    - 7 to 12 months

- c) Research grants for doctoral studies in Germany
  - for achieving the doctoral degree in Germany
  - up to 4 years
  - see also special DAAD/UCA program in some fields with University of Central Asia
- d) Research grants for bi-nationally supervised doctoral studies
  - for achieving the doctoral degree in both countries with supervisors in both countries
  - 7 to 24 months
- e) 1 to 3 months research stays for lecturers and experienced researchers
  - usually only for lectures with doctoral degree
  - not for guest lectures or participation at conferences
  - special program for study visits of artists and architects
- f) Bilateral exchange of lecturers and experienced researchers academics
  - 7 days to 3 months
- g) Re-invitation program for DAAD alumni
  - 1 to 3 months; only once all 3 years
  - special re-invitation program for alumni of the development-related postgraduate courses (see supra, II.1.d)
- h) Other research scholarship programs
  - DLR-DAAD Research Fellowship Programme (aeronautics) (daad.de/go/en/stipa50019749)
  - research and advanced education stays on language, history and culture of German minorities in CEE/CIS
- 2) Other research funding programs
  - see DAAD Scholarship Database and <u>EURAXESS</u> databases
  - doctoral study scholarships of the *Hans Böckler Foundation* (trade unions)
